A solar panel will not make a noise from normal operation, it should sit them completely motionless and silent. Noise will be coming from another component in the system or an external factor like weather.

Generally speaking, solar panels themselves don't emit a noise; they contain no moving/mechanical parts. There are other factors related to the system that might create unwanted sound.

Unlike other energy generation methods like wind turbines or combustion engines, most quality solar panels operate silently because there are no moving parts involved in their operation, which eliminates ...
