Stop using the battery if you notice these problems: odor, change in color, too much heat, change in shape, leaking, or odd noises. If it is safe to do so, move the device away from anything that can catch fire.

Share these fire safety tips to help increase awareness in your community about the fire dangers of lithium-ion and other types of batteries.

Keep batteries or devices away from anything that can catch fire. Do not charge a battery when either the charger or the battery is damaged. Do not store batteries in an area that blocks the only exit out of a room. ...

When purchased and used correctly, lithium-ion batteries are safe, but there is a risk of fire and injury if uncertified batteries or chargers are used.
