The Netherlands has an extensive network of double tax treaties with other countries. These treaties are under constant inspection and being re-negotiated to keep up with developments.

Since January 1st, VAT is no longer charged on solar panels, but it wasn't entirely clear which activities were included. The Dutch Tax Authorities have now provided clarification.
