KOTA KINABALU, March 27 -- The 100-megawatt (MW) Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) developed by Sabah Electricity is expected to begin operations in July this year.

SESB said it has received the Letter of Notification (LoN) from the Energy Commission of Sabah (ECoS) for the BESS 100MW/400MWh project, which will be developed in the east coast.

SESB chief executive officer Mohd Yaakob Jaafar announced that the project will begin this month and is expected to be completed by June 30, 2025. The BESS will enhance the Sabah Grid's reserve ...

Officially inaugurated in early 2023 on the island which houses much of Singapore's industrial and energy infrastructure, the BESS project is the biggest of its kind in Southeast Asia.
